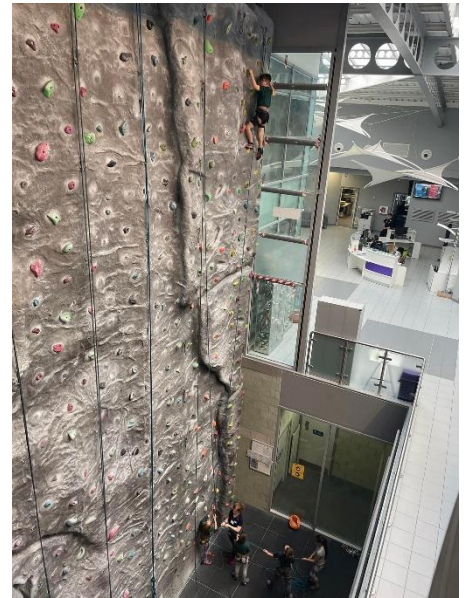


The KAA Cub pack have enjoyed an exciting and varied 2021-22 so far which included much badge work and many games, plus preparations for family camp and several activities away from the hall.
